

Message:

I thank you for tuning in this morning from wherever you are watching us. I hope you have a wonderful afternoon and a wonderful day today and I hope that I could be a blessing in some way to all of you across this nation and across the world. When I decided to step into the political arena one thing I desire was to be transparent be open and to be who I am wherever I am. And in saying so, I decided to do this webcast this morning, I have a few people tell me, "Are you sure you want to do this?"
